



POLICY ON DISPLAYS

The quality of display work makes a statement about the values and ethos of the Academy and the following principles should apply:

- that the visual appearance of the Academy contributes to its image and ethos
- that the displays in the public areas of the Academy should reflect its work and values
- that displays should be educative, informative and visually stimulating
- that displays should stimulate the students' interest and motivation
- that a pleasant environment will encourage respect, particularly if it has been created by the efforts of the students themselves

In general all displays should:

- be related to the current or impending learning of the students
- be clearly labelled
- be displayed in a 'neat and tidy' manner following basic principles of good design
- be well-maintained, and modified or dismantled when the educational value has ceased to be current

Displays throughout the Academy:

- there should be an attractive, up to date display of students' work in all rooms which are subject bases
- part of a notice board in each room should be available for administrative purposes
- the screens and cabinets in the public areas of the Academy are available for the display of students' work and can be booked for departmental use at reception.
